5. *Ensure dumpsters remain closed and leak-proof*
6. *Move stored materials indoors or keep them properly covered*
7. *Wash vehicles and equipment responsibly*
8. *Conduct routine maintenance on vehicles to prevent leaks*
9. *Make a spill response plan and clean-up kit accessible*
10. *Train employees on good housekeeping practices*
